ARTICULATION CURRICULUM SUPER PACK is designed to provide structured practice in the development and remediation of twenty phonemes and clusters. The unit is an extension to ARTICULATION CURRICULUM I, using the same structured format but the starting level requires using target sounds correctly in short sentences. Students will receive the most benefit from the program if they can successfully produce their target sounds in careful speech and structured short-sentence practice prior to beginning the unit. Students who need practice in isolated words and phrases would benefit from working in ARTICULATION CURRICULUM I prior to working in this unit.

The unit consists of 139 reproducible masters, six masters for each of the following sounds:

Directions for class use and for homework are provided at the top of each page, along with a space for the clinician's additional individual instructions. The instructions provide continuity between therapy sessions and home reinforcement practice. Pages are easily identified by the target sound set in bold print at the top of each page. The unit has 1112 stimulating illustrations that will encourage spontaneous comments or conversation and can be used in a variety of other ways to practice the target sounds.

The original copy of this unit should not be used by students but should remain as the master copy for making all additional copies. For convenience, copies can be made and filed for later use.


