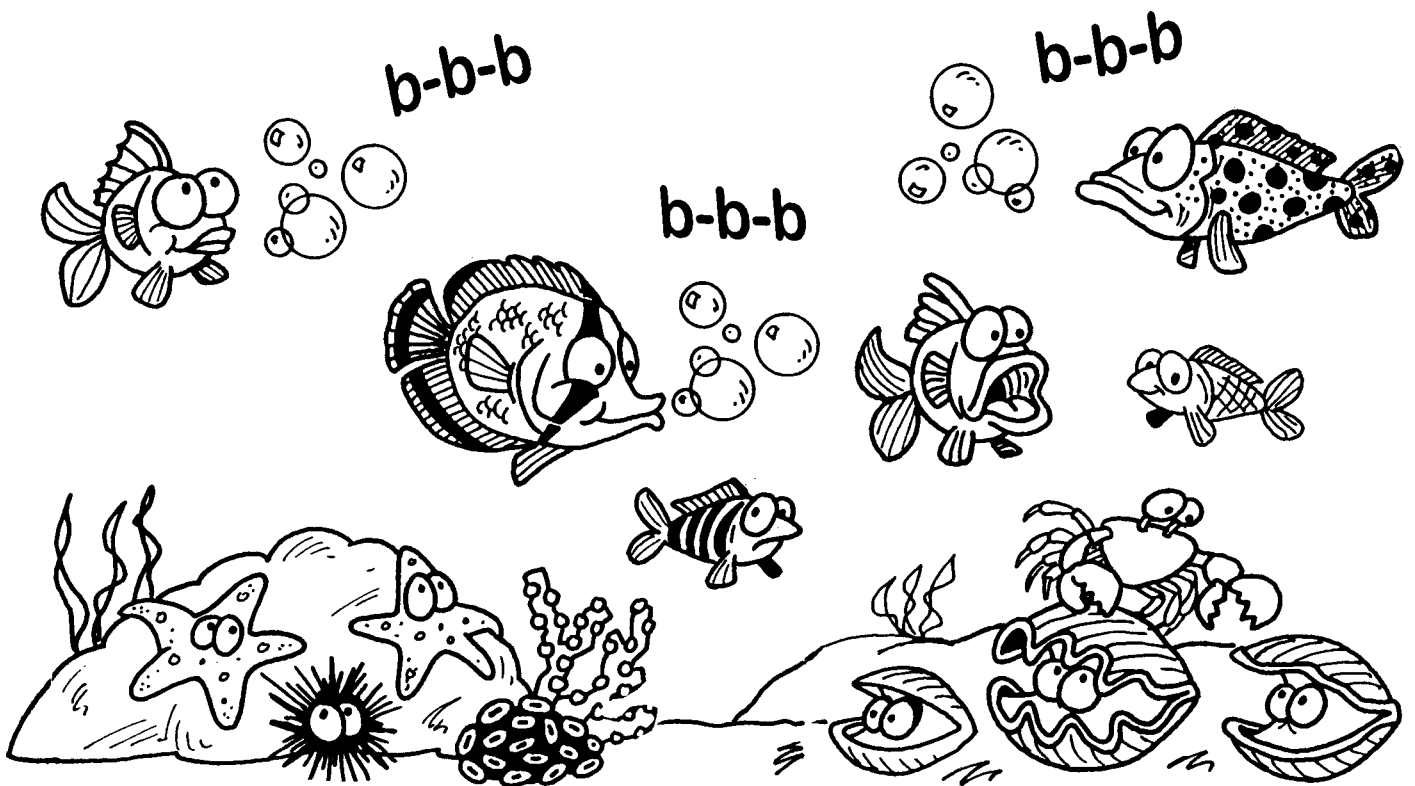


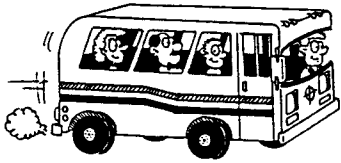
(B) is the "bubbling sound." Close your lips lightly. As you open your lips, let a little puff of air escape. Use your voice.

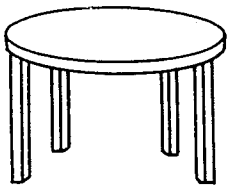

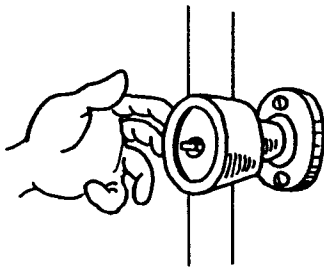

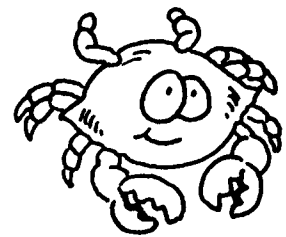
